



Aluminum, including 40%-50% recycled content

Installation:

Installation is relatively easy and does not require any previous training or special expertise. The fittings can be affixed to steel, aluminum, timber, or other substructures.

Approx Dimensions:

Approx. fitting face size: Width = 2.75" (70 mm), Height = 2.4" (60 mm)

Maintenance:

Fittings are typically supplied with the recommended "silver" powder coated or clear anodized finish, and do not require special maintenance.

Testing:

Bendheim Wall Systems' glass rainscreen systems are rigorously tested in accordance with ASTM and AAMA requirements for Water Penetration, Pressure Equalization, Air Leakage, and Structural Performance. Wall-F fittings have been fully tested in accordance with ASTM E330-02, AAMA 509-09 & AAMA 508-07. Wall-F classification: V12/W1 (stops over 90% of the water that could potentially reach the air & vapor barrier of the building. The remaining less than 10% of water is gradually dissipated through drainage and evaporation; test results available on request from rainscreens@bendheim.com). Test AAMA 508-07 is used for "Pressure Equalized Rainscreen Wall Cladding Systems." Pressure equalization prevents moisture ingress and/or helps the drainage of any moisture that finds its way behind the glass. Test AAMA 509-09 is used for "Drained and Back Ventilated Rainscreen Wall Cladding Systems." It tests whether systems are designed to manage and drain any water entering behind the cladding, and are sufficiently vented to allow the cavity to dry.
